8 events have been carried out within this project:

Event 1

Participation: The event involved 28 citizens, including 19 participants from the city of Tanagra (Greece), 3 participants from the city of Tallinn (Estonia), 1 participant from the city of Newtown (Wales), 1 participant from the city of Miranda do Duro (Portugal), 1 participant from the city of Zejtun (Malta), 2 participants from the city of Pisa (Italy), 1 participant from the city of Bolbaite (Spain).

Location / Dates: The event took place in Tanagra, Greece, from 11/05/2018 to 12/05/2018.

Short description: The aim of the event was for participants to better understand of the project aim and objectives, to increase their knowledge on the Europe for Citizens Programme, to approve management, dissemination and evaluation plans and to exchange ideas and experiences among the participants.

Event 2

Participation: The event involved 30 citizens, including 19 participants from the city of Tallinn, Estonia, 1 participant from the city of Tanagra (Greece), 2 participants from the city of Newtown (Wales), 2 participants from the city of Miranda do Duro (Portugal), 2 participants from the city of Zejtun (Malta), 2 participants from the city of Pisa (Italy), 2 participants from the city of Bolbaite (Spain).

Location / Dates: The event took place in Tallinn, Estonia, from 24/11/2017 to 25/11/2017.

Short description: The aim of the event was to investigate the level and means that EU uses in order to express its solidarity towards vulnerable groups of people as a standpoint for a deeper discussion of what actually EU stands for and its importance for Europe's future.

Event 3

Participation: The event involved 30 citizens, including 20 participants from the city of Newtown, Wales, 1 participant from the city of Tanagra (Greece), 2 participants from the city of Tallinn (Estonia), 2 participants from the city of Miranda do Duro (Portugal), 1 participant from the city of Zejtun (Malta), 2 participants from the city of Pisa (Italy), 2 participants from the city of Bolbaite (Spain).

Location / Dates: The event took place in Newtown, Wales, from 25/01/2018 to 26/01/2018.

Short description: The aim of the event was focused on providing information on EU issues and opportunities concerning young people active life and progress through presentations and discussions. Special focus was given on BREXIT (how we got there/what's next for UK?).

Event 4

Participation: The event involved 30 citizens, including 19 participants from the city of Lisbon, Portugal, 2 participants from the city of Tanagra (Greece), 1 participant from the city of Newtown (Wales), 2 participants from the city of Tallinn (Estonia), 2 participants from the city of Zejtun (Malta), 2 participants from the city of Pisa (Italy), 2 participants from the city of Bolbaite (Spain).

Location / Dates: The event took place in Lisbon, Portugal, from 08/03/2018 to 09/03/2018.

Short description: The aim of the event was to act as an open forum in order to explore some of the key issues facing citizens as part of a wider European Citizenship and how these impact on citizens locally. This forum included individuals and all sectors including education formal and non formal, business, community/ voluntary, public and private bodies, responsible for decision making to feedback and influence EU policies and programmes.

Event 5

Participation: The event involved 30 citizens, including 18 participants from the city of Valletta, Malta, 2 participants from the city of Tanagra (Greece), 2 participants from the city of Tallinn (Estonia), 2 participants from the city of Miranda do Duro (Portugal), 2 participant from the city of Lisbon, Portugal), 2 participants from the city of Pisa (Italy), 2 participants from the city of Bolbaite (Spain).

Location / Dates: The event took place in Valletta, Malta, from 19/04/2018 to 20/04/2018

Short description: The aim of the event was to work as a tool to foster inter-cultural dialogue and integration of disadvantaged groups. Each day was focused on a different theme and was targeted to different groups. On Day 1 the participants had the opportunity to exchange social heritage among people with different cultural and social backgrounds. Day 2 was dedicated to open talks about the value of diversity and belonging to a common European citizenship, with a focus group on finding proposals for EU policy enhancement.

Event 6

Participation: The event involved 30 citizens, including 19 participants from the city of Pisa, Italy, 1 participant from the city of Tanagra (Greece), 2 participants from the city of Newtown (Wales), 2 participants from the city of Miranda do Duro (Portugal), 2 participants from the city of Zejtun (Malta), 2 participants from the city of Tallinn (Estonia), 2 participants from the city of Bolbaite (Spain).

Location/Dates: The event took place in Pisa, Italy, from 07/06/2018 to 09/06/2018.

Short description: The aim of the event was to gather various representatives from different stakeholders that addressed issues such as Refugee crisis and terrorism attacks, unemployment, recession and social impact and euroscepticism and Europhobia.

Event 7

Participation: The event involved 30 citizens, including 19 participants from the city of Enguera, Spain, 1 participant from the city of Tanagra (Greece), 2 participants from the city of Newtown (Wales), 2 participants from the city of Miranda do Duro (Portugal), 2 participants from the city of Zejtun (Malta), 2 participants from the city of Pisa (Italy), 2 participants from the city of Bolbaite (Spain).

Location / Dates: The event took place in Enguera, Spain, from 13/04/2018 to 14/09/2018.

Short description: The aim of the event was to build a new understanding of Europe and discuss topics such as employability, volunteering, work and live abroad, globalization, inter cultural competences, inter cultural dialogue, interfaith dialogue, Active European Citizenship, etc.

Event 8

Participation: The event involved 130 citizens, including 90 participants from the city of Tanagra, Greece, 2 participants from the city of Tallinn (Estonia), 2 participants from the city of Newtown (Wales), 2 participants from the city of Miranda do Duro (Portugal), 2 participants from the city of Zejtun (Malta), 2 participants from the city of Pisa (Italy), 2 participants from the city of Bolbaite (Spain) and 28 international participants from other EU countries (Italy, France, Germany, Belgium, Poland, Netherlands).

Location / Dates: The event took place in Tanagra, Greece, from 22/11/2018 to 23/11/2018.

Short description: The aim of the event was to foster European Citizenship and tackle some of the main problems that the EU has faced in recent years. Citizens were actively included and together with stakeholders, policymakers and experts they made proposals for enhancements to directly improve Union's policy agenda.
